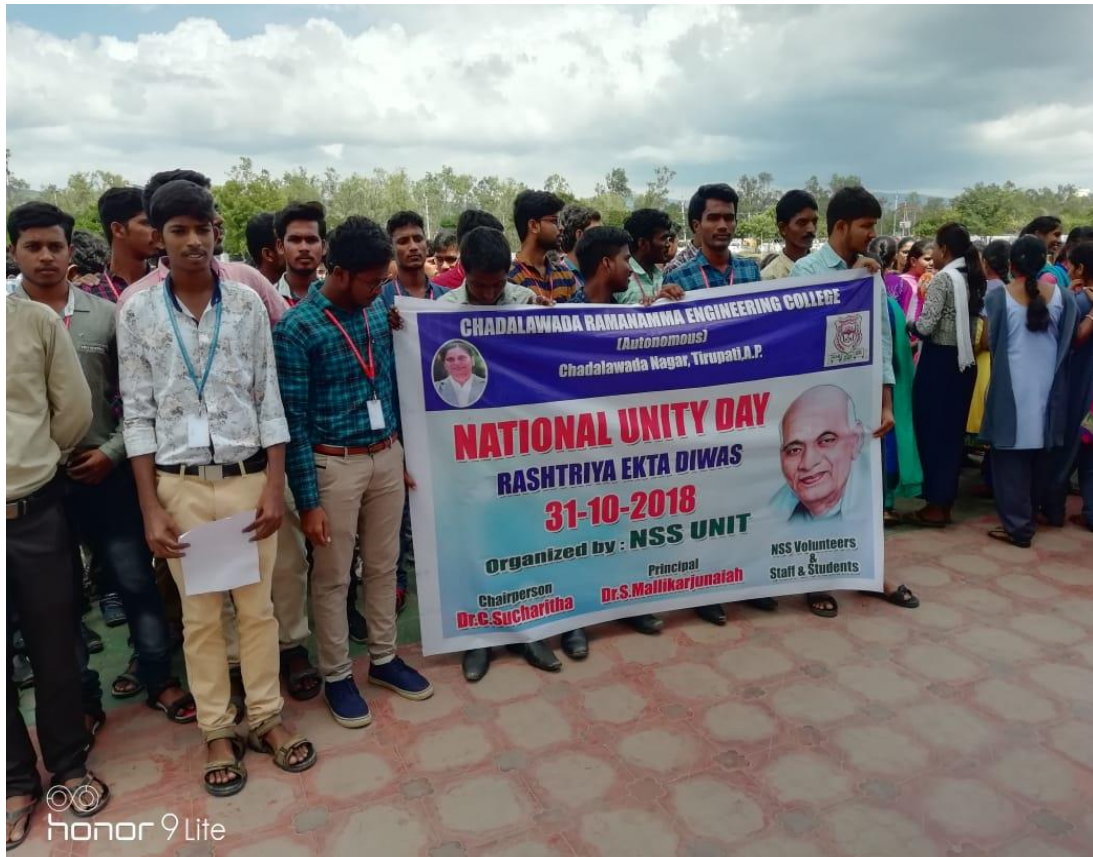

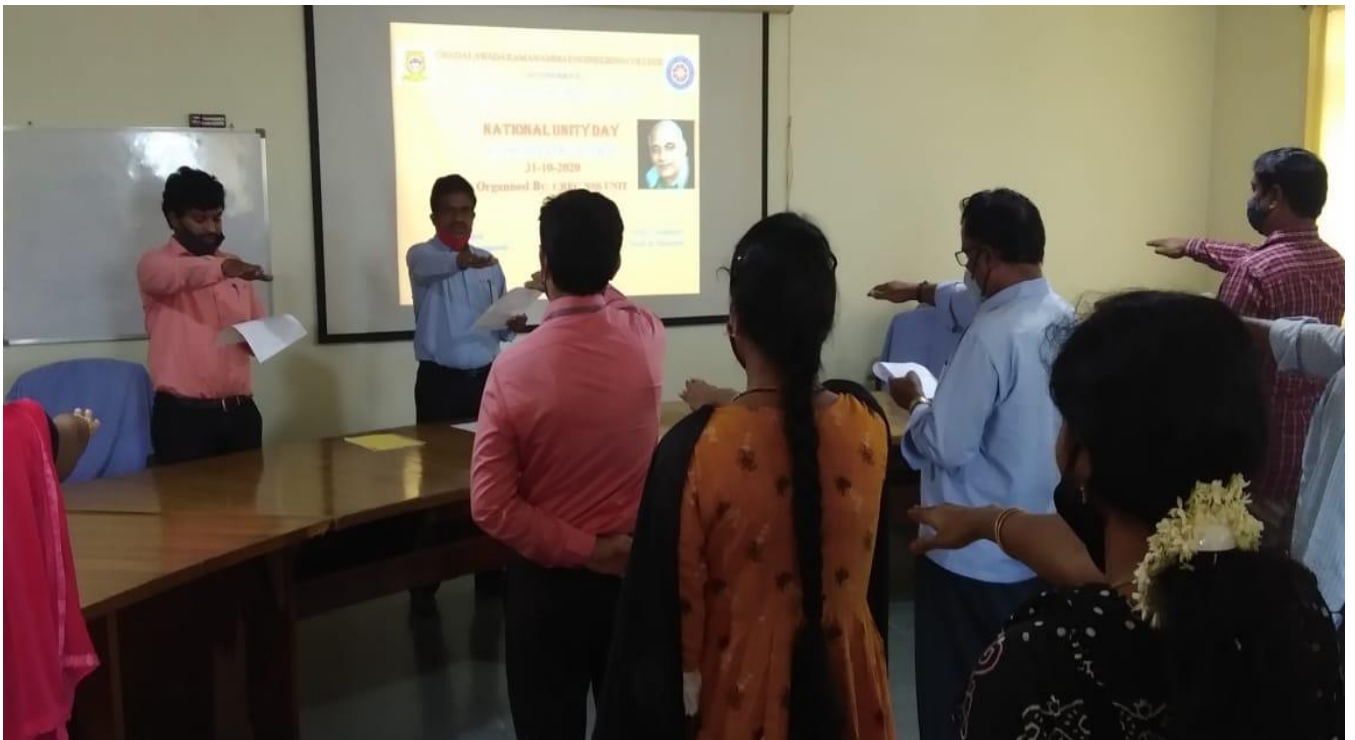

Dr. B. R. AMBEDKAR JAYANTHI (130th Birthday)

Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar (14 April 1891 – 6 December 1956) popularly known as **Baba Saheb** was an Indian jurist, economist, politician and social reformer who inspired the Dalit Buddhist movement and campaigned against social discrimination against Untouchables (Dalits). He was a great man to organize the Dalit Movement. He also supported the rights of women and laborers. He was independent India's first law minister and the principal architect of the Constitution of India, the biggest and most complex constitution in the world. Due to which he is also known as the Father of the Indian Constitution. He established the Finance Commission of India. The Reserve Bank of India runs on guidelines and ideas formed by Ambedkar.

Beloved Principal Dr. P. Sanjeeva Rayadu in his speech highlighted Ambedkar as a brilliant student earning doctorates in economics from both Columbia University and the London School of Economics. Dr Ambedkar gained reputation as a scholar for his research in law, economics and political science. In his early career he was an economist, a professor, and a lawyer. His later life was marked by his political activities; he got involved in campaigning and negotiations for India's independence, publishing journals, advocating political rights and social freedom for Dalits. He contributed significantly to the establishment of India. He converted to Buddhism in 1956 - initiating mass conversions of Dalits.

The NSS program officer briefed about the importance of that day. He also talked about the life of great personality Bharat Ratna Dr. B.R. Ambedkar. He stated that everybody should have self-respect. He also stated that Dr. B.R. Ambedkar was honoured by the highest civilian award Bharat Ratna in 1990.

This is our great honour to tribute him by celebrating and remembering on his birthday. We have conducted essay writing, elocution and debates for the students about the life history and achievements of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar. Good number of B.Tech, MBA and MCA students participated in the above events. M. Hari Priya III B.Tech ECE secured with first prize, G. 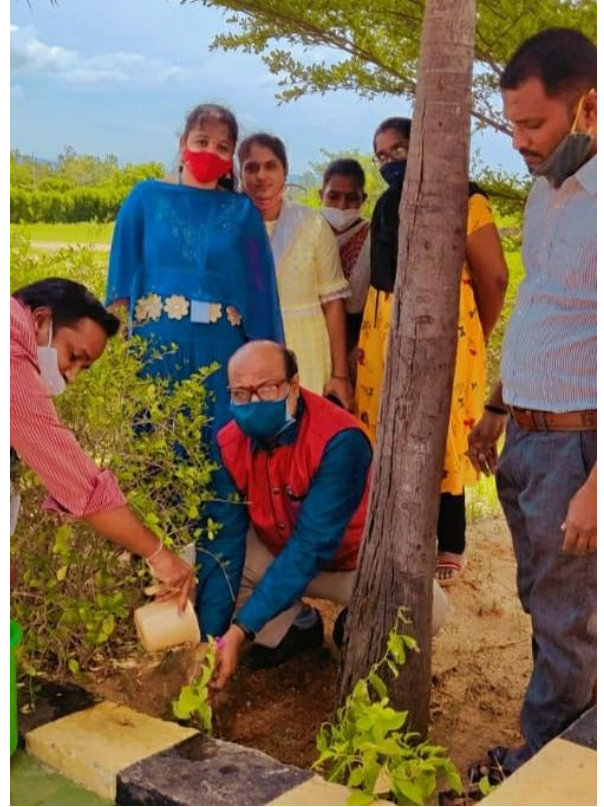

Functioning of Disha App

Disha App is an initiative taken by the Andhra Pradesh government to protect girls and women from assault by alerting the police. An alert will be sent to the Police control room if a woman in danger uses the app allowing the user to send the message. However, if the woman is not able to press the button then the woman can also send an alert to the police by shaking the smart phone 5 times. This mobile application has a single-touch SOS button that would help the women to alert the police control room and ensure a speedy response.

Android users can download this application from Google Play Store, whereas iOS users can download it from Apple App Store. The registration on the application can be done via mobile number.

Objective of the Session

In this direction the present session is organized.

- The main objective of the session is to bring awareness among the female students on the usage of Disha Women Safety App.
- How it works? What could be possible alarming situations in routine life for women?
- What they are supposed to do in uncertain encounters?
- How they could make use of this App to protect them?

All these aspects were discussed by the speaker Mrs.A.Jyotsna. The session was quite informative, educative and enlightening for female students letting them how they have to gear up for the changing norms of the society and balance themselves in various personal and professional arenas.

He later patented and installed an irrigation system with water floodgates at the Khadakvasla reservoir near Pune to raise the food supply level and storage to the highest levels. This was also installed at Gwalior's Tigra Dam and Mysuru's Krishnaraja Sagara (KRS) dam, the latter of which created one of the largest reservoirs in Asia at the time.

While serving as the Diwan of Mysore, he was awarded 'Knight' in 1915 as a commander of the British Indian empire by King George V. He received the Bharat Ratna in 1955, became a member of the London Institution of Civil Engineers before he was awarded a fellowship by the Indian Institute of Science (IISC) Bangalore.

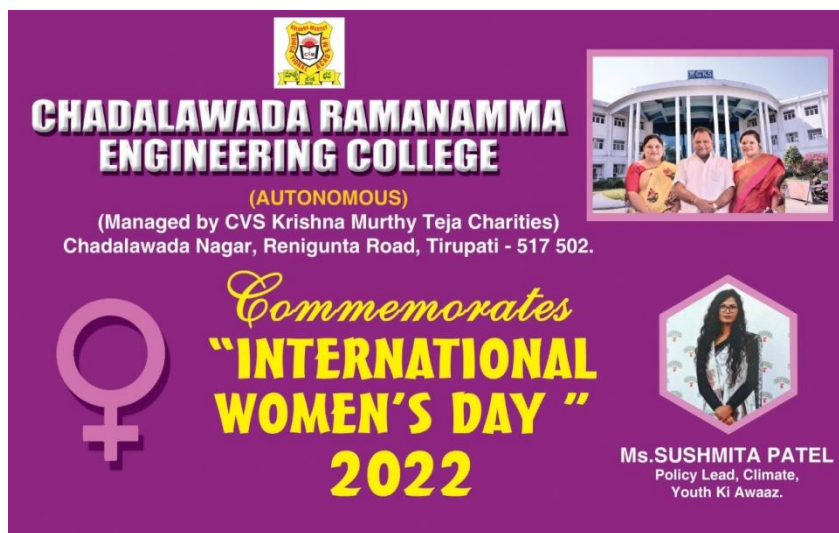

However, if the woman is not able to press the button then the woman can also send an alert to the police by shaking the smart phone 5 times. This mobile application has a single-touch SOS button that would help the women to alert the police control room and ensure a speedy response.

Android users can download this application from Google Play Store, whereas iOS users can download it from Apple App Store. The registration on the application can be done via mobile number.

The session went on for 90 Minutes with number of illustrations by the speaker and further queries of the students were also answered through the interactive session.

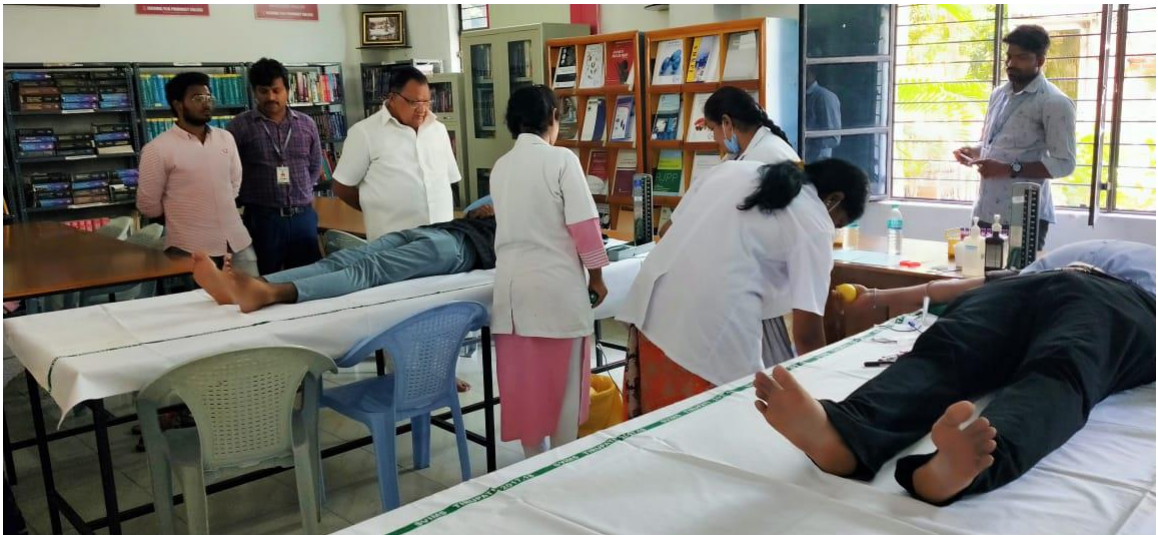

INTRODUCTION:

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME popularly known as NSS was launched in Gandhi's Birth Centenary Year 1969, under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports Govt. of India. The scheme was launched simultaneously in 37 Universities involving 40,000 students with primary focus on the development of personality of students through community service and promotion of National solidarity.

In India, the idea of involving students in the task of national service dates back to the times of Mahatma Gandhi, the father of the nation. The central theme which he tried to impress upon his student audience time and again was that they should always keep before them, their social responsibility. The first duty of the students should be, not to treat their period of study as one of the opportunities for indulgence in intellectual luxury, but for preparing themselves for final dedication in the service of those who provided the sinews of the nation with the national goods & services so essential to society. Advising them to form a living contact with the community in whose midst their institution is located, he suggested that instead of undertaking academic research about economic and social disability, the students should do "something positive so that the life of the villagers might be raised to a higher material and moral level".

NSS works on the premise that it is possible to awaken the villagers and slum dwellers to their responsibilities and develop in them the confidence, to tackle their common problems with energy, enthusiasm and in a co-operative spirit, based on mutual aid and self-reliance. The role of students is limited as activists, enablers, catalytic agents with wider communities and as programme aids.

The main objectives of National Service Scheme (NSS) are:

- Understand the community in which they work.
- Understand themselves in relation to their community.
- Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving.
- Utilize their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems.
- Develop competence required for group-living and sharing of responsibilities.
- Gain skills in mobilizing community participation.
- Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes.
- Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters and
- Practice national integration and social harmony.

SPECIAL DAY NSS CAMPING:

Special Camping forms an integral part of National Service Scheme. It has special appeal to the youth as it provides unique opportunities to the students for group living, collective experience sharing and constant interaction with community.

The primary objectives of the special camping programmes are:-

- Making education more relevant to the present situation to meet the felt needs of the communities and supplement the education of university/college/school students by bringing them face to face with the community situation.
- To provide opportunities to students to play their due roles in the implementation of various development programmes by planning and executing development projects, which not only help in creating durable community assets in rural areas and slums but also result in improvement of the condition of weaker sections of the communities.
- Encouraging the students and non-students youth to work along with the adults in rural areas, thereby developing their character, social consciousness and commitment, discipline and healthy and helpful attitudes towards the community:
- Building up potential youth leaders by exploring the latent potential among the campers, both students as well as local youth (rural and urban), with a view to involve them more intimately in development projects for longer periods.

The local leadership generated during the camps would also be useful in ensuring proper maintenance of the assets created as a result of the camps.

- Emphasizing the dignity of labour and self-help and the need for combining physical work with intellectual pursuits, and
- Encouraging youth to participate enthusiastically in the process of national development, and promote national integration through democratic living and cooperative action.

Chadalawada Ramanamma Engineering College has been organizing NSS Camp every year since its inception in 2004. The objective of this camp was to begin the interface with community, support building with community members and developing understanding of the village keeping in view the rationale of village adoption i.e. develops long term institutional relation with the community and contribution to the upliftment of people therein as well as create awareness among volunteers regarding their responsibilities towards the society. Engineering is not merely knowing and being knowledgeable; engineering is not merely analysis; engineering is not merely the possession of the capacity to get elegant solutions to non-existent engineering problems; engineering is practicing the art of the organized forcing of technological change.

Engineers play a vital role in the development of a nation. Different parts of the country celebrate Engineer's Day to appreciate the contribution of engineers.

Every year September 15 is celebrated as Engineers' Day in India to commemorate one of India's finest engineers, Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya. M Visvesvaraya is considered one of the foremost nation-builders, creating marvels upon which modern India was built. He was referred as the 'precursor of economic planning in India', according to the Institution of Engineers India (IEI). M Visvesvaraya is also known as 'VM Sir' due to his various contributions to the field of engineering and being a pioneer of education.

Born on September 15, 1861, in a small village called Muddenahalli in Karnataka, Visvesvaraya received a degree in civil engineering from Pune College of Engineering. His expertise was in the fields of irrigation and flood disaster management. He rose to fame with his groundbreaking works in these fields with modern irrigation techniques as well as flood control and mitigation.

He later patented and installed an irrigation system with water floodgates at the Khadakvasla reservoir near Pune to raise the food supply level and storage to the highest levels. This was also installed at Gwalior's Tigra Dam and Mysuru's Krishnaraja Sagara (KRS) dam, the latter of which created one of the largest reservoirs in Asia at the time.

While serving as the Diwan of Mysore, he was awarded 'Knight' in 1915 as a commander of the British Indian empire by King George V. He received the Bharat Ratna in 1955, became a member of

the London Institution of Civil Engineers before he was awarded a fellowship by the Indian Institute of Science (IISC) Bangalore.

On this great occasion CREC NSS cell took an initiative to organize Engineers Day” on 15th September. All the NSS volunteers, Staff, NSS program officer, Principal Dr. Bhaskar Patel and chairman Dr. Chadalawada Krishna Murthy attended the program.
