## 6. REVENUE GENERATED

If such event of a material breach remain unresolved/unrectified within the said notice period of 30 days or such extended period as may be mutually agreed to, the non-defaulting shall be able to terminate the Agreement forthwith.

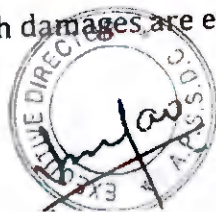
## 8. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

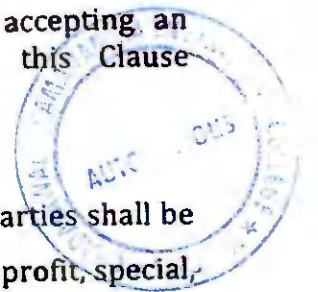

## 10. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

The Parties shall endeavor to resolve all or any dispute or difference arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, amicably within 30 days of notice in writing being issued by the non-defaulting party to the defaulting party indicating such dispute or difference. ## 11. FORCE MAJEURE

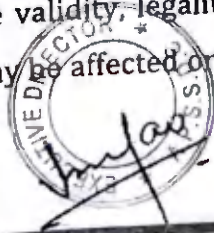
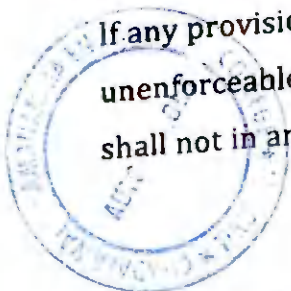
If the performance of any part of this Agreement by parties is prevented or delayed by acts of civil or military authority, flood, fire, epidemic, war or riot, or other acts beyond the reasonable control of either party, the party affected shall be excused from such performance only during the continuance of any such event.

Where a Party is claiming suspension of its obligations on account of Force Majeure, it shall promptly, but in no case later than five (5) days after the occurrence of the event of Force Majeure, notify the other Party in writing giving full particulars of the Force Majeure, the estimated duration thereof, the obligations affected and the reasons for its suspension.

The Party asserting the claim of Force Majeure shall have the burden of proving that the circumstances constitute valid grounds of Force Majeure under this clause and that such Party has exercised reasonable diligence and efforts to remedy the cause of any alleged Force Majeure. If the parties are unable in good faith agree that a Force Majeure event has occurred, the Parties shall submit the dispute for resolution pursuant to clause 10 hereof provided that the burden of proof as to whether a Force Majeure event has occurred shall be upon the Party claiming a Force Majeure event.

If any provision or provisions of this Agreement shall be held to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired there by and the parties hereto agree to

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

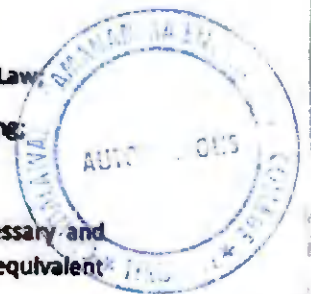
#### 7. BREACH OF AGREEMENT & REMEDIAL PERIOD

**9. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY**

The seat and venue for the arbitration proceedings shall be at Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh.

**11. FORCE MAJEURE**

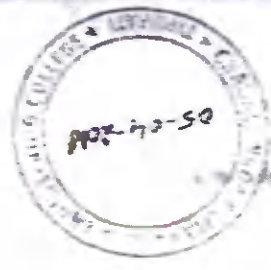

### **3. THE COLLEGE'S RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The College or its duly authorised appointee or representative shall be responsible for complete co-ordination and interaction with NIIT and shall provide the following for enabling NIIT to provide its services under this Agreement:

- a) Provide the necessary number of well-constructed dust free, furnished rooms with projection system and labs with necessary hardware and software, proper electrical supply, fittings, suitable for conducting the computer education classes. - d. Train the students using SLT. For the purpose of this clause SLT shall mean the synchronous learning technology delivered using live instructor at a different physical location and using satellite communication to deliver the

video and audio of the instructor. In case of outage due to a technical failure, a recording of the session will be made available to the College;

- e. Conduct of examination and publishing the results of the examinations as per NIIT norms.
- f. Provide placement assistance or placement assurance as applicable to each specific program to all valid and authenticated students of the college who have been promised so and who undergo the Programs and successfully complete the same subject to such students meeting the terms and conditions of the said promise.
- g. NIIT would also provide certificates, at the end of each training program, to students undergoing and successfully completing the Programs based on the results declared by NIIT.

## 5. CONSIDERATION

The reciprocal considerations shall be detailed out in the SOW or SOWs that will be executed between the Parties later on. The fees received by the Parties for the services provided by a party to the other shall constitute sufficient consideration for entering into this Agreement.

## 6. CONFIDENTIALITY

- 6.1 The College undertakes to NIIT the following in respect of Confidential Information:
- (a) to treat Confidential Information as confidential, using the same degree of care as it uses for its own confidential information of like kind, but in no event less than reasonable care;
  - (b) not to, without NIIT's prior written consent, communicate or disclose any Confidential Information to any person except only to those of its employees, on a reasonable and justified need to know basis.
  - (c) not to otherwise use or circulate such Confidential Information within its own organisation except solely to the extent that NIIT may authorise in writing;
  - (d) to effect and maintain adequate and appropriate security measures to safeguard such Confidential Information from unauthorised access, disclosure, use and misappropriation;
  - (e) not to copy, modify, enhance or create derivative works of the Information or reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble or reproduce the Confidential Information without prior written consent of NIIT.

6.4 Upon request the College shall promptly deliver all Confidential Information supplied by NIIT and all copies, work product or other derivatives thereof and, destroy or erase any Confidential Information and any materials and documentation containing such Confidential Information, including all originals, copies, computer data files, word processing files, letters, or other computer storage files, forthwith. NIIT shall certify in writing to the College that it has fully complied with its obligations under this Clause.

6.5 The College shall not make nor permit others to make any reference of the Confidential Information or use the name, trade name, trademark, logo, acronym or other designation of NIIT and its Affiliate and their agents or clients in any public announcements, promotional, marketing, sales materials or efforts or otherwise without the prior written consent of NIIT.

## 7. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES:

Both Parties represent and warrant to each other as follows:

- A. The execution of this Agreement, the consummation provided for herein and the fulfilment of the terms of this Agreement by such Party shall not (i) result in the breach of any of the terms and provisions of, or constitute a default (after notice, or passage of time, or both) under, or conflict with, or any other agreement or instrument by which such Party is bound or (ii) violate any judgment, decree, order or award of any court, governmental body or arbitration or any applicable law, rule or regulation.
- B. Both Parties have the authority, representation and capacity to enter into this Agreement and they have the necessary approval/ clearance/ license/ permission from then concerned authorities/persons.

The College will not either represent itself to any third party including the public at large to be a franchisee or partner or agent of NIIT. It will also not offer NIIT Courses or Programs to any third party including the public at large.

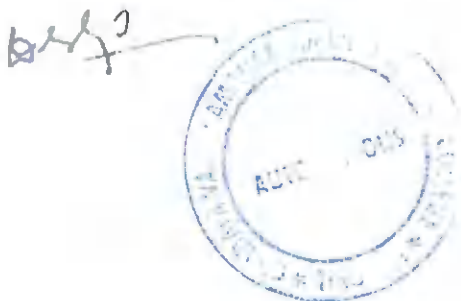
#### 10. NON-COMPETE

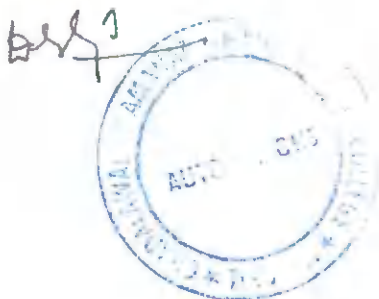
## 13. TERM AND TERMINATION AND CONSEQUENCES THEREOF AND

Proven breach on the part of College shall mean prolonged inaction by the College to remedy any core issue covered under this agreement and non payment of dues under this agreement continuously for a period of not less than 30 days and forming subject matter of a written intimation by the NIIT to College on expiry of the 30 day period and failure to adequately remedy the

same within a reasonable period thereafter which in any event shall not be less than 15 days after receipt of this intimation.

- d. This Agreement can be terminated at will by effecting a 30 days' written notice. However the same shall not be effective and applicable during continuance of any Program plus completion of the next semester of any Program under this Agreement or relevant SOW and the parties shall be liable to the respective obligations till then. However in that event NIIT shall not be liable to conclude any uncompleted Program, as the case may be.

**13.2** Notwithstanding the circumstances in which, or the reasons for which, such has occurred, following the termination of this Agreement, the following provisions shall apply:

- (d) The College shall not adopt, register or use any mark deceptively similar to the trademarks of NIIT.
- (e) Within a period of thirty days of the termination of this Agreement for whatever reason, the NIIT may at its own cost, take back all technical information and reference Materials books, records, papers, discs or other media all embodiments of technical know-how, intellectual property rights and Confidential Information. Where it is not practical to take back all copies thereof, the College shall destroy all such copies under the observation of NIIT personnel within the period above said.
- (f) All rights and obligations accrued before the Termination shall survive the post termination also.

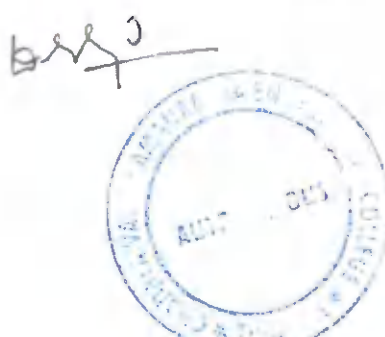

1. Monthly usage should equal or exceed the benchmark usage for atleast one month in a quarter. A monthly mini-report will be sent to each institution. Failure to clear benchmark usage will take the instance from 'Active' to 'Watch List'.
  - (a) If the usage for the institute in Watch List continues to be below benchmark, it will be moved to 'Suspended' state. The instance cannot be accessed or used in 'Suspended' state.
  - (b) A suspended instance can be re-instated after an explicit written request from the head of institution within 2 months of suspension. If no request comes within this period, the instance will be 'Deleted'.
  - (c) If the instance comes back into Watch List state right after re-instatement, it will be 'Deleted'.
2. The benchmark usage is calculated as  $10 \times (\text{Total Student Count of Institute})$  pageviews/hits per month.
3. Institute wanting a new instance after deletion will have to go through a New Instance Request process.

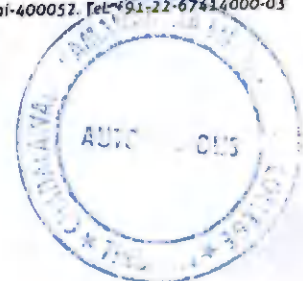

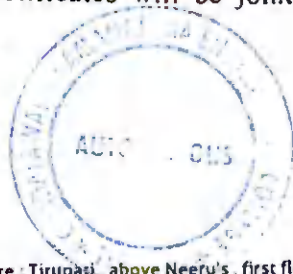
**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS UNDER:-**

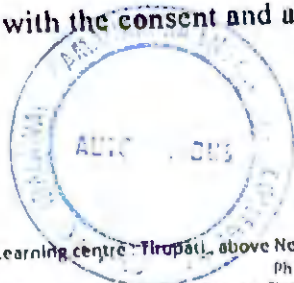
- 2.1.8 The minimum number of students per batch will be forty (40).

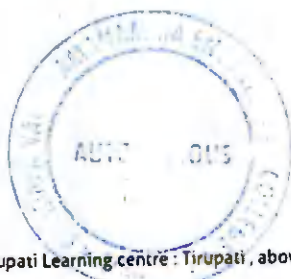

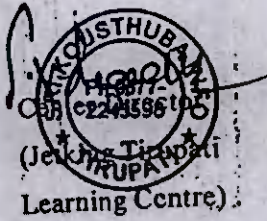
