Code of Conduct & Regulations of the Institute

1. All students admitted to the Institute and hostels are subject to the discipline and control of the Institute authorities. The students are required to adhere strictly to the rules and regulations.
2. Every student shall carry his/her Identity Card and shall produce whenever asked for.
3. The student should adhere to the dress regulations prescribed by the Institute. i.e. for Boys -- a formal dress & for Girls – salwar suit. Sleeveless dresses are not allowed.
4. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Any student found to have indulged in ragging will be summarily expelled from the Institute as per the rules stipulated by the Government.
5. The students are not authorized to organize meetings or join discussions on public matters.
6. Smoking, drinking alcohol and use of drugs are strictly prohibited.
7. The students are required to show due regard to the property of the Institute. Any student found guilty of defacing or damaging property like furniture, equipment, fixtures, books, building, vehicles, etc. of the Institute or of hostels is punishable and is liable for expulsion from the Institute.
8. No student should take law into his/her own hands whatever may be the circumstances. Any case of personal violence by a student on any other person will be viewed seriously and dealt with severely. The student should represent any difficulty through the Head of the department to the Principal and the decision of the Principal in these matters shall be final.


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9. The students shall behave in a disciplined manner and follow all the instructions issued by the Principal from time to time and shall not indulge in any act of indiscipline within or outside the premises of the Institute or Hostels that shall be unbecoming of a good student. Every student should endeavor to uphold the values, the good image of the Institute.
10. Every student should be punctual in attending the classes, tutorials, submission of assignments and mid-tests or otherwise they will lose marks proportionately.
11. Students are required to put up attendance of not less than 75%. Condonation of shortage of attendance will be granted only once during the course of 4 years.
12. Proper observation of Institute discipline, good conduct and participation in sports and games and other events will play an important role in recommending for the final University Examination or any special scholarship or for a job at the end of the course or for the award of a certificate at the time of leaving the Institute.
13. A student shall not be permitted to appear for the University Examination unless he/she has paid all his/her dues of the Institute/Hostel and his/her progress, conduct and attendance are found to be satisfactory.
14. The Institute authorities under no circumstances shall accept any liability in respect of an accident/suicide which a student may meet with or commit during his stay at the Institute or on an educational visit. The students are, therefore, cautioned to conduct themselves in a careful manner.
15. The Principal reserves the right to suspend, if any student fails to pay the Institute / Hostel dues in time and has a consistently poor performance.
16. The Principal reserves all the rights to delete, add or amend the rules and regulations as and when felt necessary.

17. The students will strictly abide by the various undertakings etc submitted by them from time to time.

FOR THE HOSTELS

1. Inmates of the Hostel should stay only in the rooms allotted to them by the Warden. They should not either interchange the rooms among themselves or shift to another room without the prior permission of the Warden.
2. Inmates of the Hostel should not entertain any guest or outsider in their rooms. If the parent of any student happens to visit and desires to stay in the hostel, the concerned student should inform the same to the Warden and take permission.
3. Inmates should not leave station without informing the Warden. They must observe the study hours from 9am onwards on all days. During the inspection visits of the Warden, if any student is found to be not present in his/her room, disciplinary action will be taken against him/her.
4. Timings: All the girls must be in the hostel by 6.00pm. Boys must be in the hostel by 7.00 pm and after 9.00 pm, they are permitted only by prior permission from the concerned warden/Sr. warden and by depositing their I-Card.
5. Hostellers who desire to go out on genuine reasons such as purchase of books, etc. should apply to the Warden in writing stating the purpose and the place of visit and obtain prior permission for going out.
6. Inmates are responsible for the furniture and other fittings (switch boards, lights, fans, etc.) provided to them. They are expected to check the above when they occupy the room. They are required to hand over all the above items in good condition when they vacate the Hostel. Cost of damages, if any or losses of the above will be recovered from them.
7. Inmates should not use electrical appliances such as heaters, table fans, rechargeable lamps, irons etc.



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8. Hostellers should not disfigure surface of walls, doors and windows by writing or pasting posters, calendars, etc. If any person violates the rules he/she is liable for expulsion from the Hostel.
9. Boarders of the Mess should observe decency and decorum in the dining hall both in dress and in table manners.
10. Boarders should observe the mess timings as notified from time to time by the Warden.
11. Guests will not be allowed on credit basis.
12. Extra food items to the maximum extent of Rs. 50/- per month will be allowed to any boarder provided he/she does not have arrears. Extras will be permitted only if the required items are available in surplus.
13. Residents who are involved in any act of indiscipline either in the dining hall or in the rooms or outside the Hostel will be liable for expulsion or rustication from the Hostel as decided by the authorities.
14. Students expelled from the Hostels will not get any refund of room rent or the deposit.
15. Students entering into the campus after consuming intoxicants will be liable for serious punishment.
16. Hostellers should vacate and handover the furniture and fittings in the rooms in good condition at the time of leaving the Hostel for summer vacation.
17. Students, who are granted condonation of attendance, will not be entitled for hostel accommodation.
18. The boarders of mess are not supposed to carry the food to their rooms from the mess without prior permission from warden/sr. warden.

All the inmates are expected to strictly adhere to the above rules and regulations or otherwise, they will be liable for disciplinary action as decided by the Hostel Management.

FOR THE LIBRARY

1. Library is open from 9am to 6.30 pm, with one hour lunch break on all days.
2. All the students should enroll as members to borrow books from the Library.
Each member can borrow three books.
3. Reference books and Encyclopedias will not be issued.
4. Books will be issued for duration of 15 days.
5. Books which are returned can be re-issued immediately to the same borrower.
6. Fine@0.50 rupee per day per book will be charged if a book is not returned on the due date.
7. If a book is lost or torn of, an amount equal to the cost of the book plus will be recovered from the borrower.
8. For reservation of books, applications are to be given to the Library Assistant.
9. Students are not allowed to carry their own text books/guides inside the Library.
10. A special Book Bank facility is available for the SC/ST students.
11. The student may keep the books for one semester and should return to the Library after the completion of University exams.
12. Using mobile phones in the library is strictly prohibited and if found using the same, mobile phones shall be confiscated.
13. Whispering, murmuring and discussing in the reading area is strictly prohibited.
14. The Library is under the CCTV surveillance.
15. Kindly leave the books on the reading tables only after using them.
16. Photo copying facility is available in the library.
17. E-Journals are subscribed by the library in the interest of students and faculty members.

On 25th Nov, 2022 Women Protection Cell (WPC) -CREC (A) in association with DMS CREC(A) commemorates **International day for the elimination of violence against women** as a Day-I event of **Discrimination against Women Pakhwada 2022**. M.RANGANADHAM GARU, Retd. Superintending Engineer was the chief guest at the inaugural session held at 11: 00 AM in CSE Seminar Hall CREC (A). He spoke about the importance of the women's protection cell and stressed the safety measures that CREC (A) is taking to protect Girl students and Female faculty members. Director Dr.Bhaskar Patel delivered a speech on the equality of Women and men in different areas and suggested showing the hidden figures movie to all the students and faculty members as this is a story of empowerment, of black women overcoming the double barriers of race and gender.

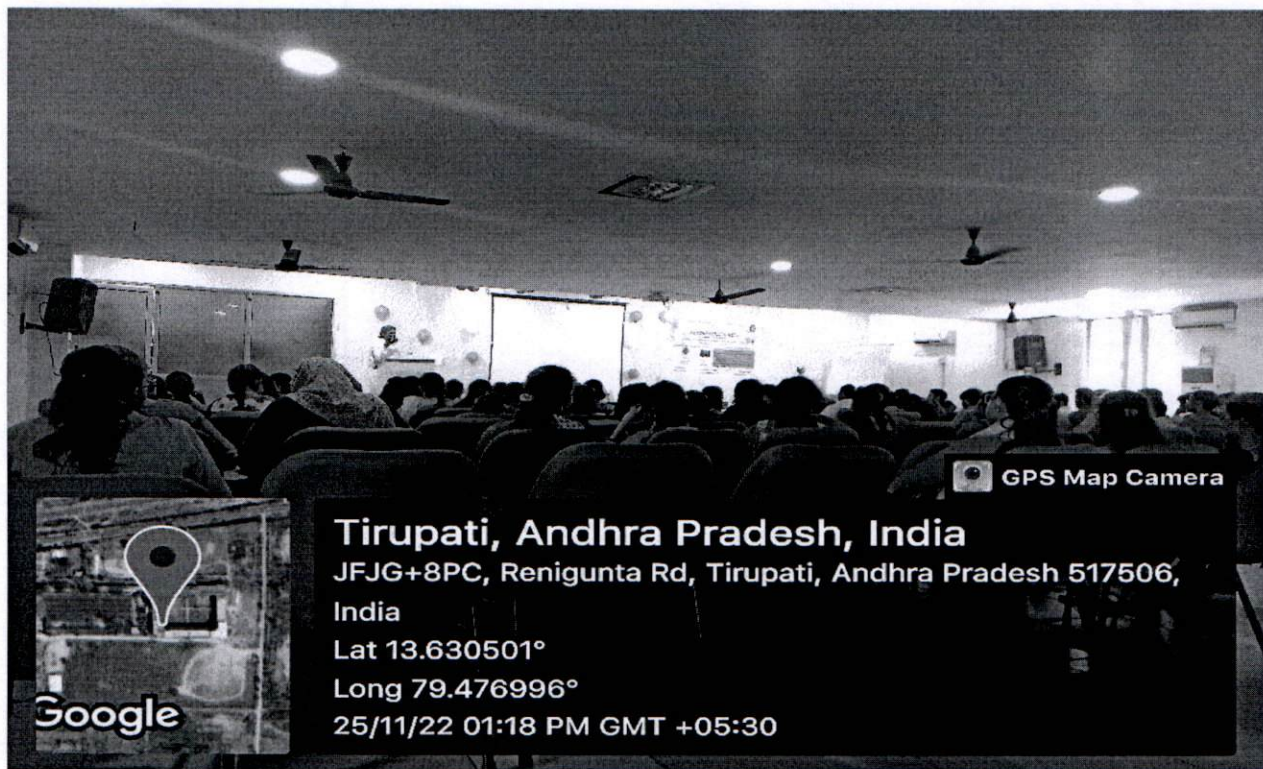
In the first session of the first day of the program, CHMS.RAJU, Advocate, High court, delivered a lecture on the importance of gender equality and the need for precautions to be taken are explained in detail. He focused much on legal awareness and described the Constitutional provisions under the Dowry act, and remedies illustrating realistic examples. Further, Divulged practical knowledge about the basic legal rights and remedies provided under various women-

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related laws, thereby making them fit to face the challenges in real-life situations. Students of MBA-IY, MCA-IY, and CSE-III Y all of around 300 along with faculty members actively participated and benefited in this awareness session. The session went on for 1 hour 30 min with number of live examples by the speakers and further queries of the students were also answered through the interactive session.

In the second session of the first day of the program,

M.Radhika, G.Vaishnavi, B.S.Sharmila Began, Mahila Rakshana karyadarsi (Renigunta police station) addressed the students on sexual assault and abuse prevention. Ms.Radhika, MSK, Renigunta (Urban) police Stressed on issues of sexual assault on campus. She said according to the Rape Abuse and Incest National Network, 26.4 % of undergraduate women fall victim to sexual assault or rape. That's about one out of every 4 women are at risk of sexual assault in college campuses and in some cases, may be elevated , off campus. In addition, and especially during this pandemic, substance abuse is on the rise and substance abuse can give rise to sexual assault. She discussed about some live incidents that happened across India. In Hyderabad for allegedly sexually assaulting a minor girl. Trapping a girl through social media,

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so do not share personal photos or details to the unknown persons. Communication about sexual assault awareness in college is must both on campus and off.

G.Vaishnavi, B.S.Sharmila Began spoke about the best practices for communicating sexual assault awareness on college campus. They suggested non-biased approach, campus climate surveys, student advocates and supporters as prevention aids for sexual assault on college campus. Students of ECE-IY & IY, EEE-IY& IY, and MECH-IY all of around 175, and concern faculty members took part in the session.

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In the third session of the first day of the program.

N.Hemavati, S.Latha, S.Tejaswini Dillip, K.L.N.Poornima-Mahila Rakshana karyadarsi (Renigunta police station) were invited as guest speakers for the session. They addressed the students on the issues of child brides, Gender inequality in education & workplace. N.Hemavati, K.L.N.Poornima-Mahila Rakshana karyadarsi (Renigunta police station) talk on how child marriage ends childhood and children's education rights. She expressed that child marriage is often the result of entrenched gender inequality, making girls disproportionately affected by the practice.

She explained the various laws enacted against child marriage and punishments. Informed students about ChildLine 1098 if they come across child marriages.

N.Hemavati, said Gender Inequality in education is a persistent problem within the Indian society, especially for the girls, belonging to economically weaker sections of the society. Gender inequalities are important in various dimensions, these include, education, health, employment or pay. She shed light on the Programs Promoting Women's Education which are being enacted by the government to promote gender equality, empowerment opportunities among women and end to discriminatory practices against women - The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya (KGBV).

S.Latha, and S.Tejaswini Dillip, informed all the students about Use of "Disha SOS" App and how it works? What could be possible alarming situations in routine life for women? What they are supposed to do in uncertain encounters? How they could make use of this App to protect them?

She shown that this mobile application has a single-touch SOS button that would help the women to alert the police control room and ensure a speedy response. Asked students who are Android users to download this application from Google Play Store, and whereas iOS users from Apple App Store. They educated girls to install this app on their mobile. Provided some helpline numbers, like 1091-Women helpline number, Disha helpline 181 or 112 etc. The session was quite informative, educative, and enlightening for female students letting them how they have to gear up for the changing norms of society and balance themselves in various personal and professional arenas. Students of ECE-IIIY, EEE-IIIY, CSE-IIY, and MECH-IIY all of around 123 along with faculty members actively participated and benefited from this session.

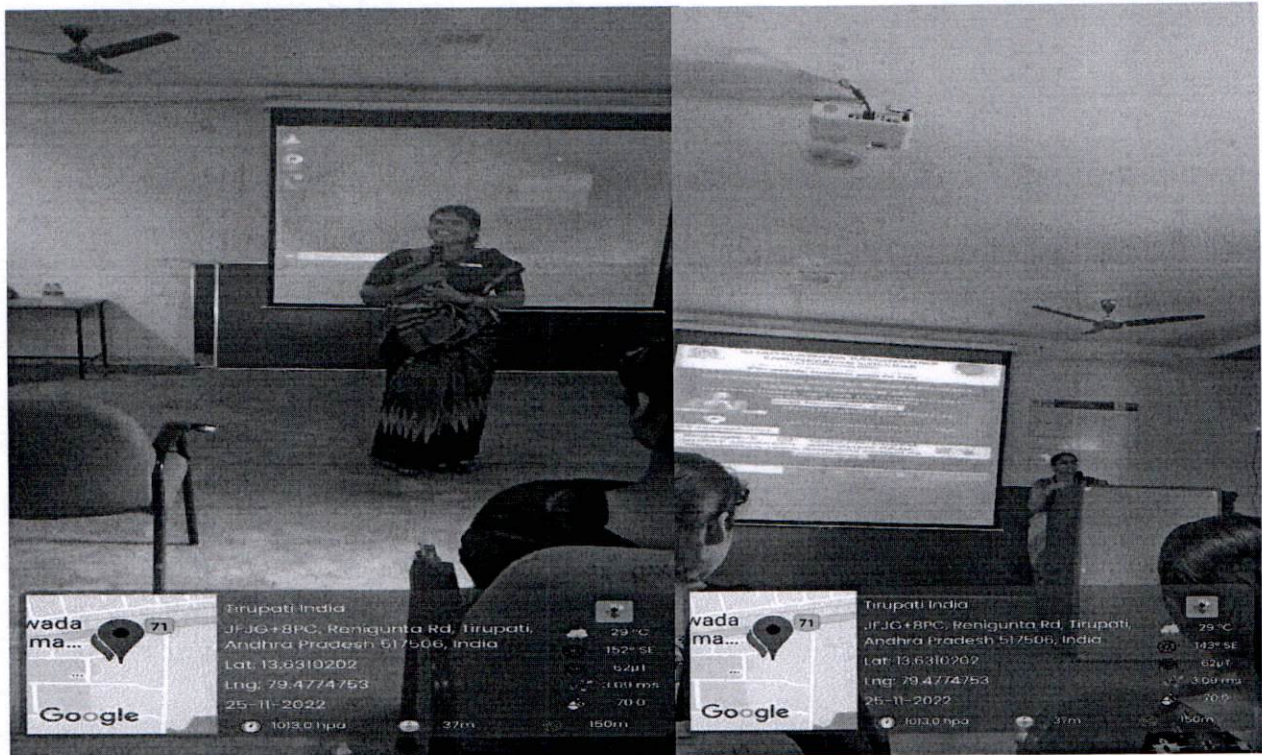

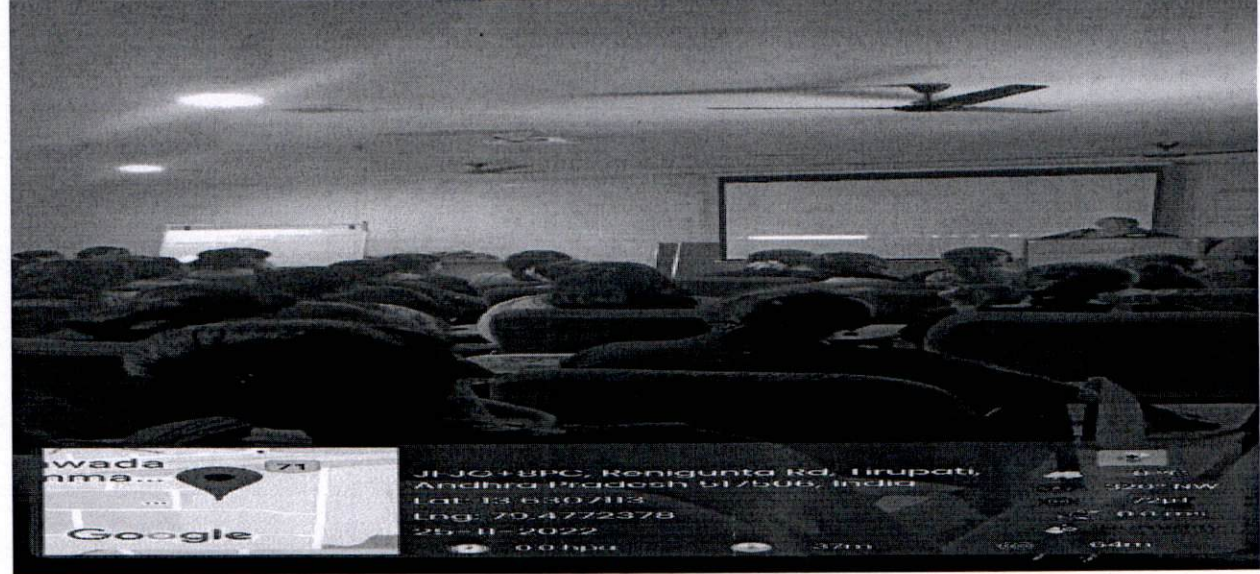
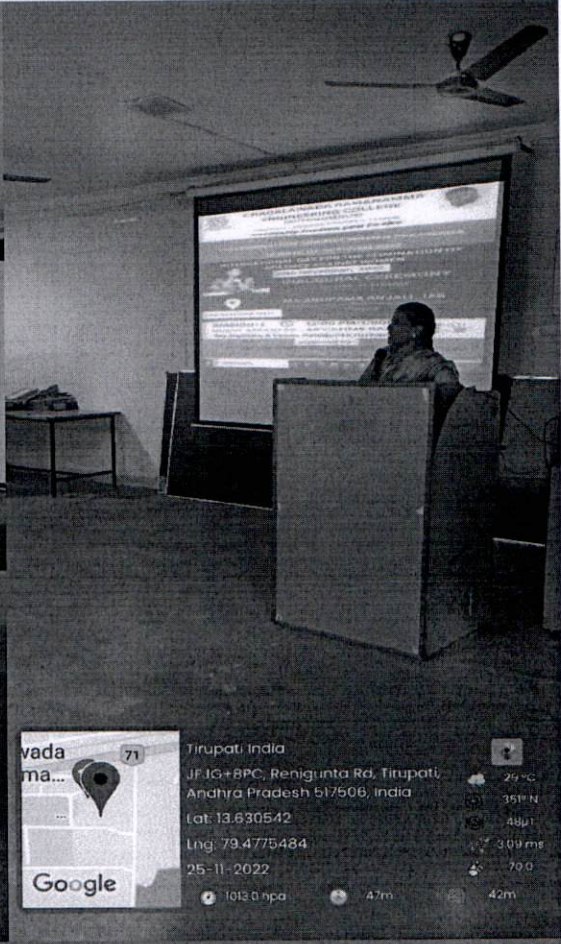
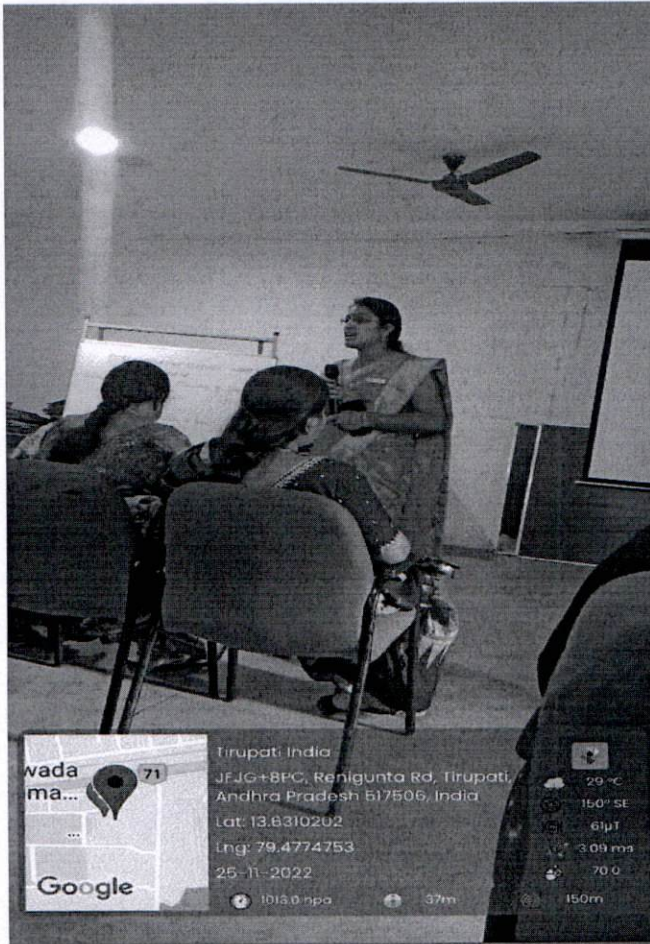
Feedback from the Students on the session

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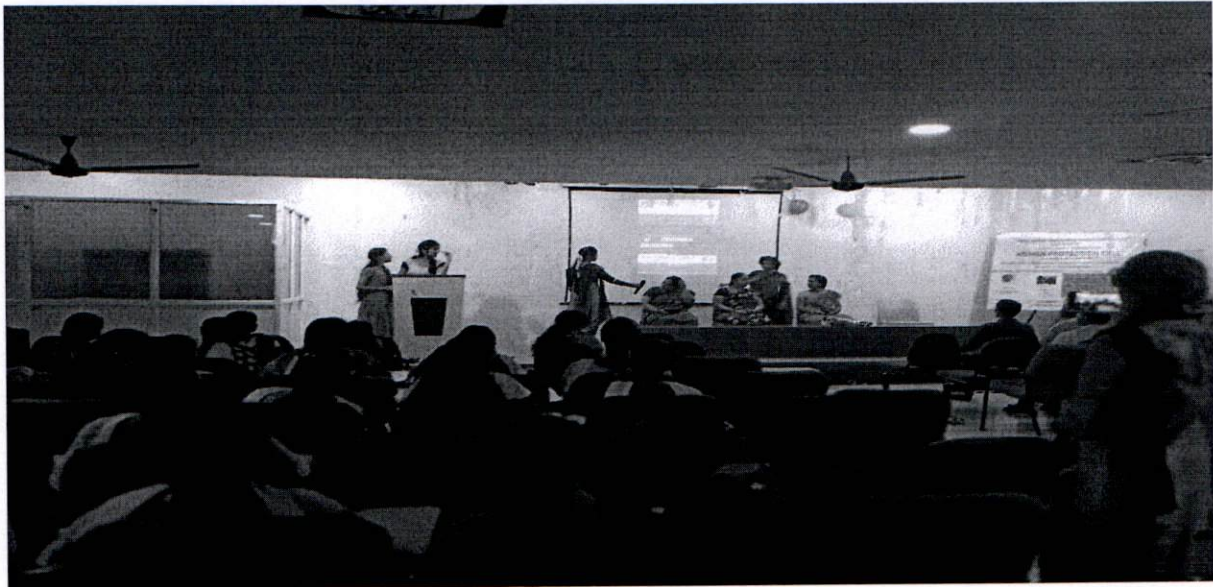
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ONE-DAY WORKSHOP ON “HUMAN VALUES AND PROFESSIONAL ETHICS”

Report Dated 26/11/2022

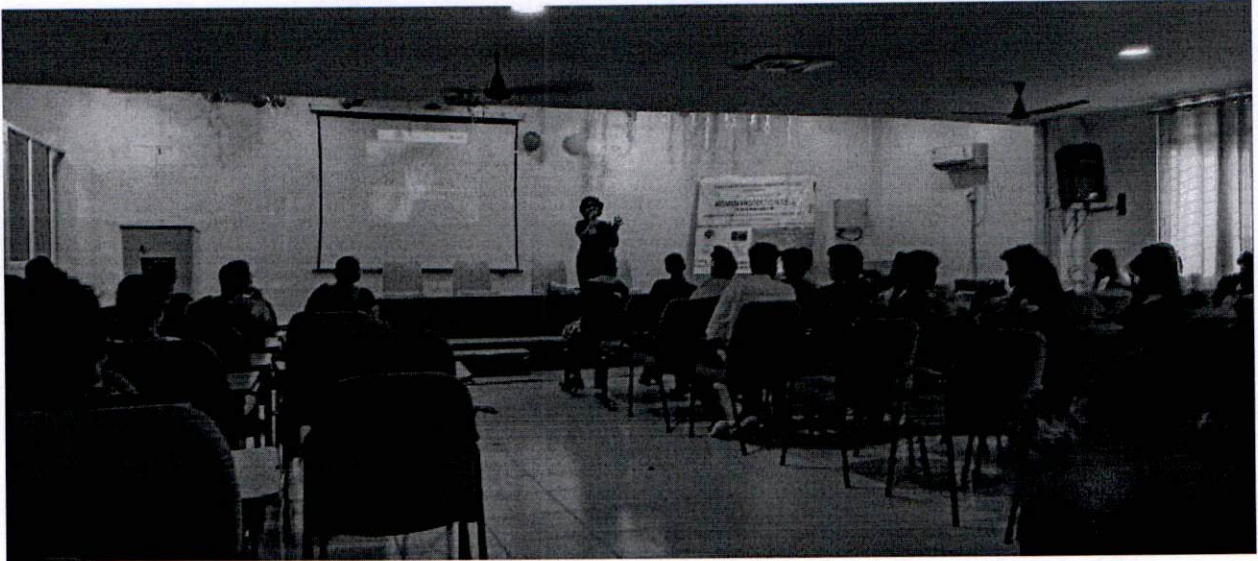

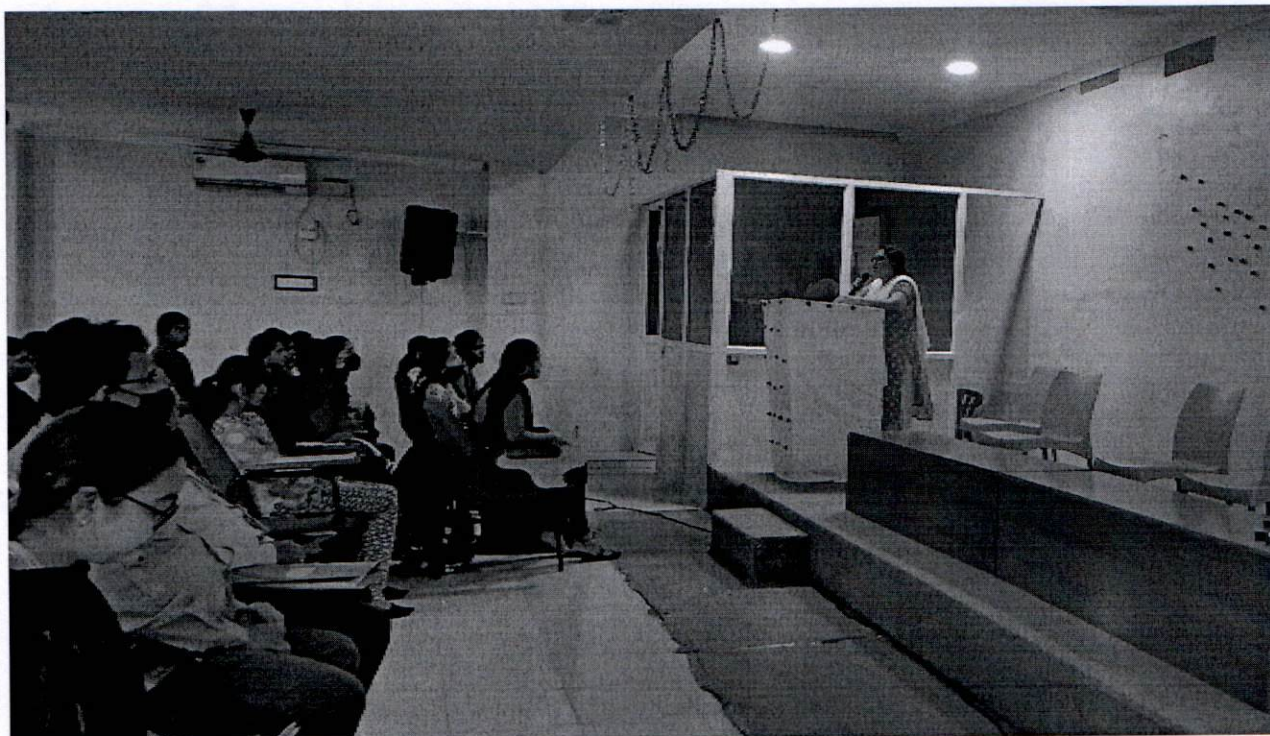
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GENDER SENSITIZATION, HUMAN VALUES, PROFESSIONAL ETHICS

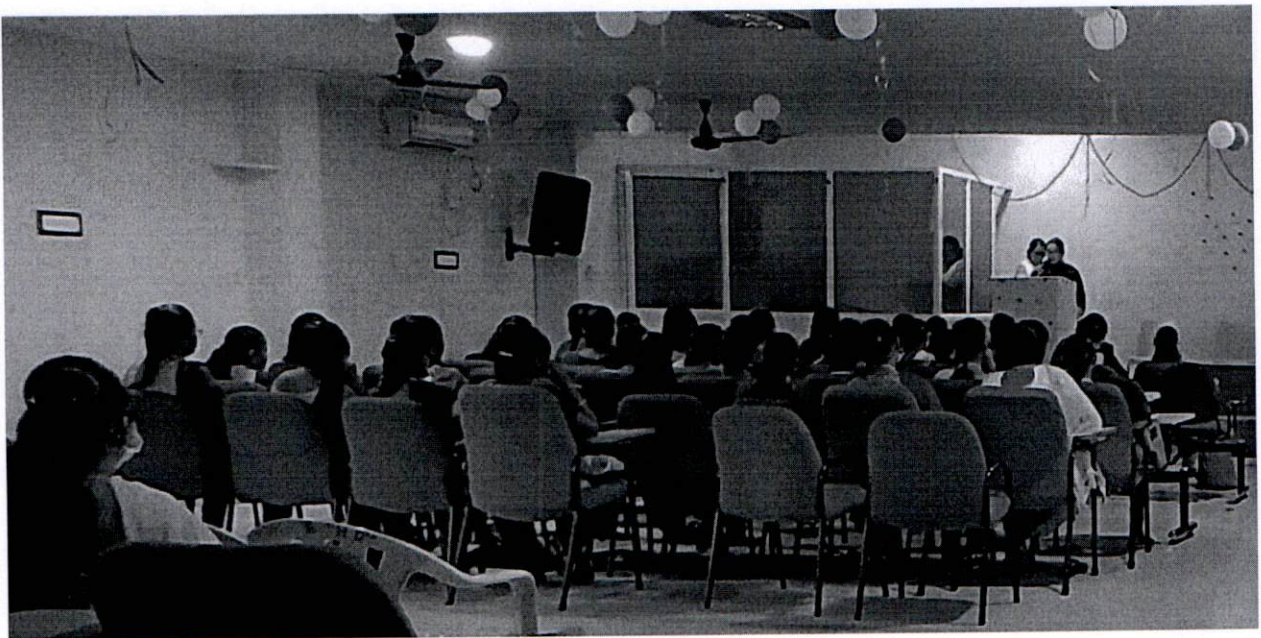
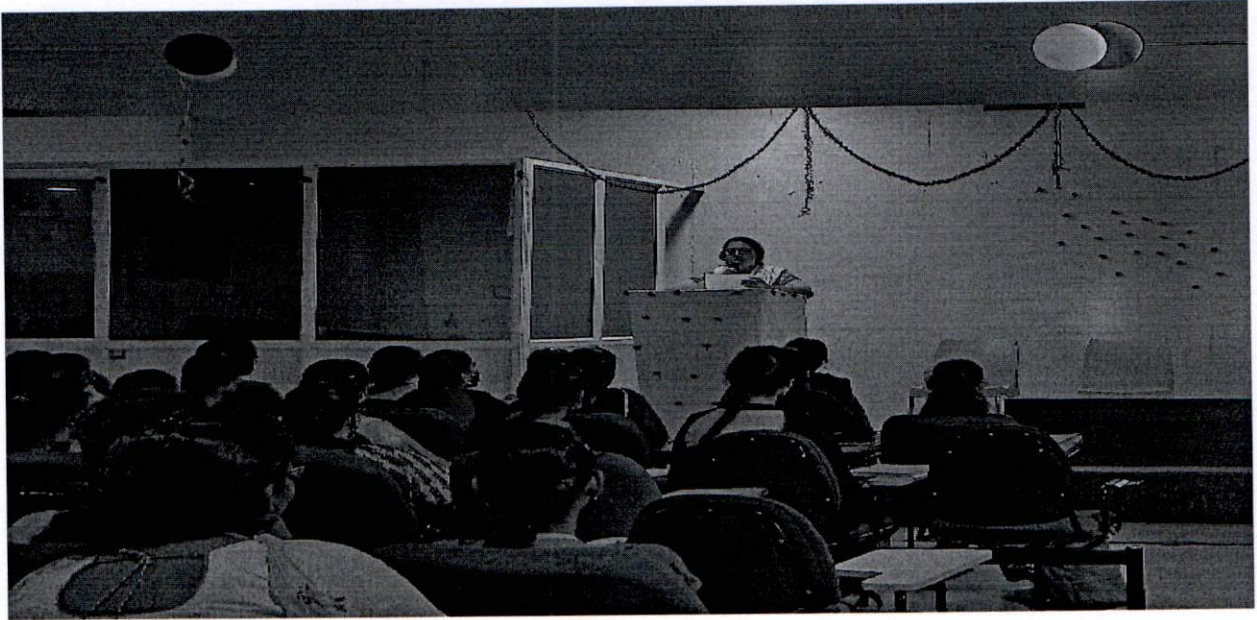

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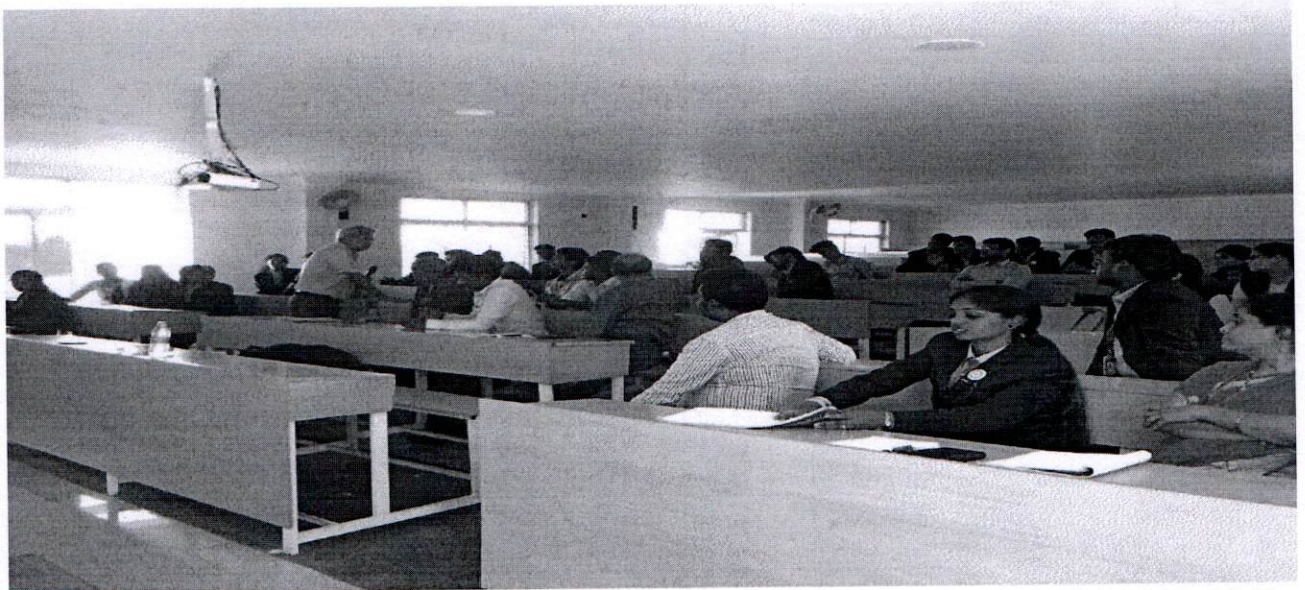

His observations during this interactive workshop are invaluable. A total of 45 MBA students and 25 engineering students participated in the session along with faculty members. The session was held at CRE Auditorium from 10:00 AM to 3:30 PM.

He emphasized the need for exploring new ways of different dimensions in the individual, in society, in the family, and in any organization as a whole. Students are still in a confused state, though they have vast experience through their 20 years of an academic career. Only trained people have to take up the main responsibility to guide and lead them in the right direction. Acharyas are those who practice well and show them in action. Teachers are to be role models for society. Their efficiency reflects in society.

Healthy competition must be established for a healthy society.

Addressing on purity and impurity, he stressed that priority must be given to purity to lead life happily.

The word 'I' is nicely associated with our physical pleasures to fulfill our needs, but he stressed the difference between human beings and animals, explaining the evolutionary process of human beings.

Worrying about the future adversely affects our present. We are working hard for our daily needs in the future, thinking of our past. It decides our victory.

No one can deny, the need for human values in the present education system, but how to inculcate them in children remains as a million-dollar question.

Misunderstanding is the main cause of anger. So problems should be solved through debate and discussion in a friendly atmosphere. A teacher is transformed like a magnet with his self-discipline. Unforgettable knowledge in the subject turns out to be wisdom and is useful for fellow beings. Finally, for whatever we want to earn, first, we should be aware of what it is about and how to utilize it.

Desires are not infinite but their presence is continuous and they follow us. Unless we have a positive response to our problems, we lose our wisdom. What we are losing in the present society is peace. We are very happy when we do our work with a better understanding. Logic is not a tool for problem-solving. If we lose our wisdom, it leads to indiscipline.

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The basis of harmony in society is harmony in the family for which the base is harmony in the human being. At the individual level, unhappiness is more due to a lack of fulfillment in the relationship. Most of our time and effort is spent on the physical facility. Efforts should be made to equally divide our time and effort for body and relationship.

Even the education setup should empower independent thinking, impart holistic inputs, and a proper understanding and facilitate the development of the competence to live with Definite Human Conduct.

The session focused on dividing the self into two components. One component has **Realisation & Understanding**, the other has **Desire, Thought, and Expectation**. Whatever we want to do, we should go by the first component and not directly by the second. For that, we need to put a **Proposal** and check whether it is **Naturally Acceptable leading to Mutual happiness**. If our desire passes through these i.e. it is naturally acceptable and leads to mutual happiness and we can proceed further. Or else we need to avoid it.

This entire session is lively, stressing the need for self-awareness. Time and again, he pointed out that he is was not meant to give any solutions to problems, but only to show a better way to a peaceful life.

This session started with 'I'. Then it changed to, 'We'. Self-assessment is the main motto of this lively session. Everyone's inbuilt power and ability are equal by birth. Internal interaction with everybody is happiness. We can keep away unresolved problems by maintaining good relations.
